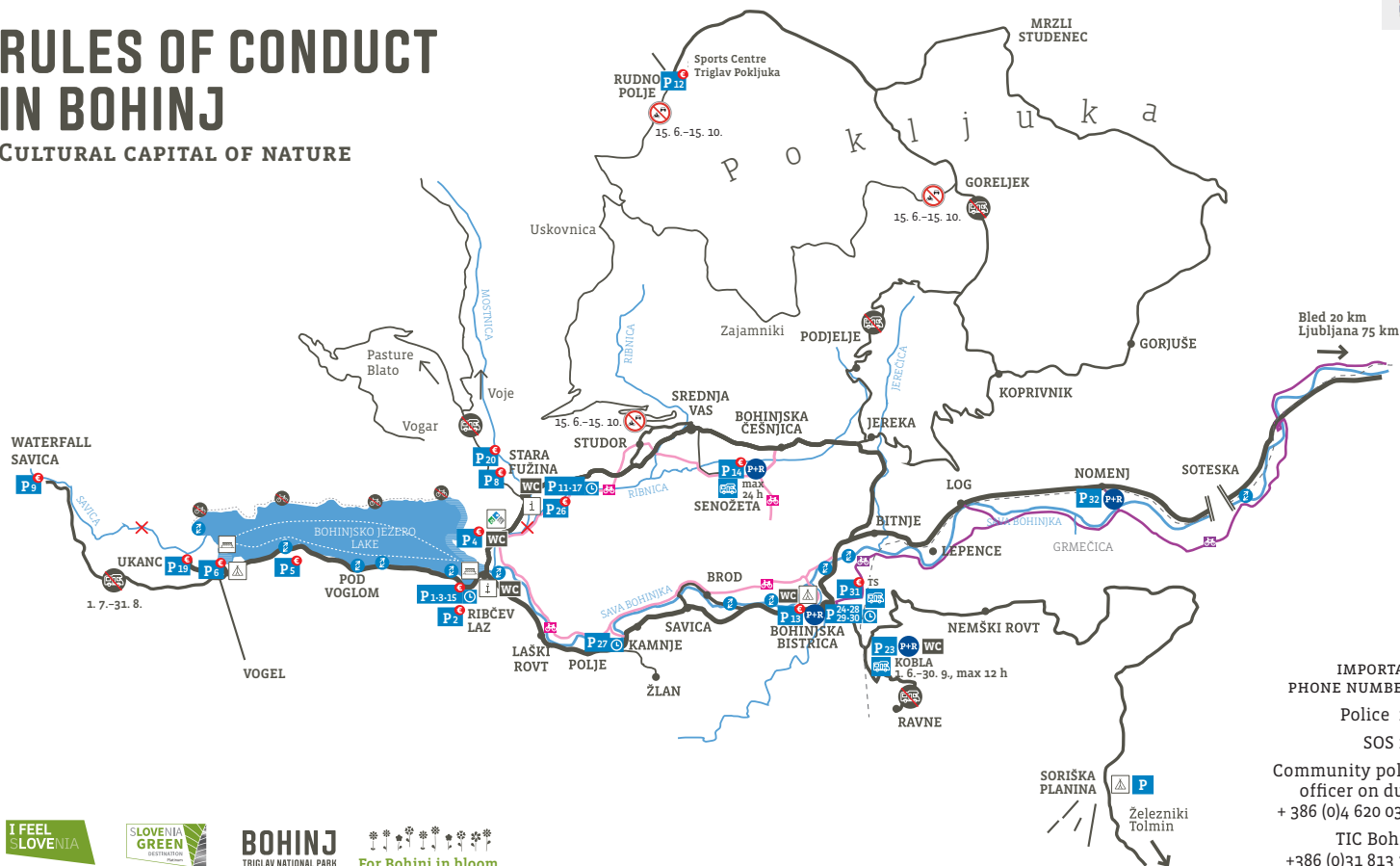

Use environmentally-friendly ways of transport.

Parking is only allowed in designated car parks.

The cheapest car parks are available in **Nomenj, Bohinjska Bistrica and Srednja vas**. In summer, buses ride from P+R car parks and villages to Lake Bohinj and other attractions.



Meadows, pastures and forests are owned by local farmers. Walk only on **marked trails**.

Drink **tap water**. Running water in village troughs is also drinkable.

Do not make **noise** or disturb the peace and quiet at night.

Please do not leave your rubbish behind. Put waste in proper **waste containers**.

The use of **drones** is prohibited in the natural environment without the prior consent of the national park.

Please use **public toilets**.

Tenting, bivouacking and sleeping outside the designated areas is not allowed.



Dogs must be kept on a **leash** and please clean up after them.

Dogs may swim in Lake Bohinj, but only outside the designated bathing areas.



Bohinj Cycling Route and unpaved roads are also intended for **farm machinery**.

Cycling along the north shore of the lake, along skid trails and mountain trails is prohibited.



Motor vehicles and bicycles should be used only on designated roads. Motorhomes and camper vans are not allowed on forest roads.

If you travel with motorhomes, camper vans and other vehicles, you can stay overnight only at campsite and nighttime motorhome and camper van car parks.



Lake Bohinj and Sava Bohinjka River can be accessed only at **entry and exit points for vessels**.

Clean the vessel. All vessels should have a valid **boating permit**.



Swimming is recommended in the designated areas. **Swimming in Triglav Lakes and Mostnica River** in the Triglav National Park area is **not allowed**.

It is prohibited to play loud music on Lake Bohinj shore. The use of large bathing accessories is not allowed (excluding vessels and bathing safety equipment).

It is not allowed to roam the area of the bridge and the Church of St John the Baptist in swimwear or shirtless.
